





Background

Introduction to Shortcuts




- Originally called Workflow, a project from the University of Michigan's MHacks (2015)
- Apple acquired Workflow (2017)
- Workflow became Shortcuts for iOS 12 (2018)
- Shortcuts became a default iOS app for iOS 13 (2019)
- Shortcuts app announced for macOS (2021)
- Shortcuts is an automation tool for macOS, iOS, and iPadOS, allowing users to automate tasks.
 A combination of actions and shortcuts can be used to create complex workflows integrating different services and apps.

Challenges

Why Shortcuts?

- Efficiency and Time Savings: Automation with Shortcuts can streamline repetitive tasks
- Consistency and Accuracy: Minimizes human error, ensuring that actions are performed consistently and accurately
- Customization and Flexibility: Shortcuts offer the ability to create custom automation workflows tailored to specific organizational needs
- **User Empowerment:** Allowing non-Jamf Pro Administrators to perform management tasks through user-friendly shortcuts
- Overall, using Shortcuts with the Jamf Pro API can lead to a more efficient, accurate, and scalable management process for Apple devices in an organization.

Getting Started




• Set Up Authentication Variables: Within the Toolbox Pro app, choose Variables and create

- access_token





Getting Started



- Download Shortcuts: GitHub Jamf Pro API Shortcuts
 - Within the Shortcuts app, I have organized my Jamf Pro shortcuts into two containers, Jamf Pro Modules and Jamf Pro Actions
 - Jamf Pro Modules Contains shortcuts that are meant to be re-used and called by the actions shortcuts
 - Jamf Pro Actions Contains individual asks that you are requesting from Jamf Pro








Demonstration Redeploy Jamf Framework








